Scripture for Study: Luke 11:4

Review

- Praying for forgiveness means learning how to admit that you are unable to manage your life without God's divine assistance.
- Praying for forgiveness means trusting that God's grace is something that is everlasting.
- Praying for those who sin against us means faithfully trusting that God is willing, able, and ready to forgive and has forgiven those who have wronged us.

2. What would you confess to him and what would you say sorry for?
3. Why is it so difficult to say, "Please forgive me?"
4. What are your spiritual battles that you fight against?
5. Define temptation. What are the things in your life that lead you into temptation?

Season of Lent

The season of Lent begins on February 17th at 6:30pm with an Ash Wednesday service in the sanctuary. Lent is a 40-day liturgical season that begins on Ash Wednesday and concludes on Easter Sunday. Sundays are not included in the 40-day count because every Sunday is a joyful celebration of Jesus' resurrection. Though not biblical, Lent has long been a tradition in the Christian Church, and it is thought that the tradition of the 40 days recalls the 40 days Jesus spent in the wilderness, fasting and being tempted by Satan Matthew 4:1-11. Lent is considered a time of penance and discipline. We invite you to come join us as we look at the journey Jesus made to the cross. Stay tuned for additional Christian Education opportunities during Lent which we will announce in church or via this newsletter update.
